1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.111 dated 24.05.2022 registered under Sections 363, 347 & 376-D of IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station City, Kapurthala.
