The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant outstanding salary of the petitioner from 01.11.2021 to 31.12.2024, amounting to ₹20,20,496, along with interest at the rate of twelve per cent per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the President of respondent no.5/Society is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 27.01.2025, Annexure P-6, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Satjot Singh Chahal, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 27.01.2025, will be decided by the President of respondent no.5/Society expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the President of respondent



no.5/Bhotna Multipurpose Cooperative Agriculture Service Society Ltd., to consider and decide the pending legal notice, dated 27.01.2025, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within three months of receiving a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found eligible for the claimed benefit, the same will be released to him within four weeks thereafter.
