Prayer in the present civil revision is for issuance of directions to the learned Executing Court in Execution No.526 of 2017 to decide the execution (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner/plaintiff/Decree Holder that the suit of the plaintiff was decreed by the learned trial Court vide judgment and decree dated 11.9.1980 (Annexure P-1). The appeal filed by the respondent/defendant was dismissed by the learned lower Appellate Court vide judgment and decree dated 04.8.1984 (Annexure P-2). Even the Regular Second Appeal of defendant No.2 was allowed vide order dated 17.1.2006 (Annexure P-3); whereafter the SLP No.5106 of 2017 filed by the petitioner was partly allowed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 10.4.2017 (Annexure P-4). Learned



counsel for the petitioner submits that immediately thereafter the petitioner had filed the present execution petition on 08.9.2017. However, the same has not been decided by the learned Executing Court till date. It is accordingly prayed that a direction be issued to the learned Executing Court in Execution No.526 of 2017 to decide the same expeditiously in a time bound manner. In support of his submissions, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated **06.3.2025** passed in **Civil Appeal Nos.3640-3642 of 2025** (arising out of SLP(C) Nos.8490-8492 of 2020) titled as "**Periyammal (dead) through LRs and others vs. V. Rajamani and another etc.**".

Heard.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, issuance of notice of motion is dispensed with at this stage, as it will cause further delay in disposal of the case.

In view of the given facts noted above, the present petition is **allowed** and the learned Executing Court is directed to dispose of the Execution No.526 of 2017 (Annexure P-5) expeditiously, preferably within six months from today in compliance of the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 06.3.2025 passed in **Civil Appeal Nos.3640-3642 of 2025** (supra).

Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
