Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the impugned notice dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-6) qua the petitioner, issued by Sub Divisional Officer, Tibri.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for staying the impugned notice dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-6) qua the petitioner and order dated 26.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Collector, Gurdaspur.

2. Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him. He submits that the application for stay filed by the petitioner along with his statutory appeal

under Section 9 (1) of the Punjab Public Premises and Land (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1973, is pending consideration before the Appellate Authority for 12.06.2025 and in all probabilities, the said prayer for grant of stay would be considered by the concerned authority on the date fixed, i.e. 12.06.2025, and not in any case, beyond a period of three weeks thereafter; after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition is accordingly, disposed of.

4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
