1. The plaintiffs-appellants had filed a suit for declaration with consequential relief of mandatory injunction, which was dismissed by the trial Court and the appeal filed therefrom by the plaintiffs-appellants was also dismissed.

2. On 09.10.2000, a Coordinate Bench of this Court while issuing notice of motion was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Mr. Harish Rathee, Advocate.

-x-

Notice of motion for 22-1-2001.

Till further order, respondents are restrained from disturbing in study of the appellants.

9-10-2000”

3. On 22.01.2001, when the matter was admitted, the said interim



order was made absolute. The order dated 22.01.2001 is reproduced hereinbelow:-

*“Present: Mr.Harish Rathee, Advocate
Mr.N.S. Bhinder, DA Haryana.*

...

Admitted.

*Since the appellants are not living in the hostel, no prejudice is going to be caused to the respondents if during the pendency of the appeal they are allowed to continue their studies in the school. Accordingly, interim order dated 9.10.2000 is hereby made absolute.
22.1.2001”*

4. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that in all probability, the present appeal has been rendered infructuous as the case is of the year 2000 and the appellants, who were students, would have completed their studies.

5. None has appeared on behalf of the appellants to rebut the said aspect.

6. Accordingly, the present appeal is disposed of, at this stage as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the appellants to revive the present case in case any cause survives.
