1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.31 dated 04.04.2025 registered under Sections 333, 74, 115(2), 126(2), 127(2), 191(3) & 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

2. As per office report, service is complete. However, none has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 28.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gagandeep Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the
