HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, proceedings are sought to be initiated against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 02.09.2013 passed by this Court in CWP No.21263 of 2011. The relevant portion thereof is extracted hereunder:-

“(2). During the course of hearing, Mr. Khosla, learned counsel for the GMADA on the basis of the recommendations dated 31.08.2013 made by the Officers’ Committee states that the structures/houses of the petitioners situated within the revenue estate of Village Chao Majra, Tehsil and District Mohali have been decided to be exempted/released from acquisition.”

2. Learned Senior counsel representing respondent Nos.2 and 3 submits that in compliance of order dated 17.09.2024 petitioner was called for hearing on 19.09.2024 and necessary compliance in terms of the said order stands made.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, submits that he wants to re-argue the case on merits, as this Court is to decide how much area is open space outside the house.

4. Since there is no such direction in the order of the Writ Court, this Court is only concerned about compliance of the order dated 02.09.2013, which has already been complied with by the respondents.

5. In such circumstances, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

6. Dismissed as having become infructuous.

7. Rule stands discharged. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
