1 The appellant has sought the relief for anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of FIR No.192 dated 06.06.2024 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379-B, 506 of IPC and Section 3(2)(v) SC/ST, Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Narnaul.

2. Reply dated 06.05.2025 by way of affidavit of Suresh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, on behalf of respondent No.1 – State filed in Court today is taken on record.

3 Learned State counsel, on instructions has apprised the Court that in compliance of the order dated 28.04.2025 passed by this Court, the appellant has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.
