This common order shall dispose off the present two contempt petitions as the same are arising out of the common order dated 24.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Writ Court.

[2] Pursuant to the previous order dated 27.02.2025, in COCP-5200-2024, learned counsel for the respondent(s) has filed an affidavit dated

07.03.2025 of sole respondent, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite side.

[3] The aforesaid affidavit dated 07.03.2025 contains a communication dated 05.03.2025 written by the office of respondent, addressed to the Secretary, Subordinate Services Selection Board, SAS Nagar, Mohali, thereby requesting to recommend five candidates out of the petitioners of CWP-22824-2013 and CWP-3650-2017 against five vacant posts of Junior Technician (Blacksmith).

[4] Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that every possible effort shall be made to get the recommendation from the Subordinate Services Selection Board, SAS Nagar, Mohali within 15 days from today followed by the appointment of recommended candidates.

[5] In view of the above undertaking, nothing survives for adjudication in the present contempt petitions, the same are **disposed off** accordingly.

[6] Rule stands discharged.

[7] The remaining petitioners, if at all any still grievance, they are at liberty to avail their remedy as per law.

[8] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
