1. The present petition has been filed Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of directions respondents No.2 & 3 to conduct an enquiry against the private respondents in the event of of murder of son of the petitioner (namely Kuldeep Singh son of late Mithu Singh) as the petitioner has suspicion on the act and conduct of the private respondents that they in connivance with each other committed murder of her son to grab the land of petitioner's son and take action on her representation dated 08.04.2025 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation on 08.04.2025 before the Officer In-Charge, Police Station Jogam District Mansa, Punjab (Annexure P-1) raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has



been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3- Station House Officer, Police Station Moga, District Mansa, Punjab to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 08.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
