1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.30 dated 01.02.2024 under Sections 420 & 34 IPC (Sections 406, 120-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Faridabad N.I.T. District Faridabad, on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

2. A fact revealed out that complainant (respondent No.2) is not willing to settle the dispute with third accused namely Jacob. Therefore, prayer made in the present petition cannot be accepted in law as per observation made by Division Bench of this Court in **CRM-M-48043-2023 titled as *Rakesh Das vs. State of Haryana*, 2024 NCPHHC 147654 Law Finder Doc Id #2663704.**

3. Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh and comprehensive one by impleading all the required parties, if the dispute is settled amongst all the parties in future.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as sought and recorded hereabove.
