SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. Respondents No.3 to 6 have filed separate compliance reports by way of affidavits, a perusal of which indicates that certain amounts of monetary benefits have been extended to the petitioners by way of various cheques/bank drafts.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.3 to 6 further submits that the State of Haryana has preferred Petition for Special Leave to Appeal No. 25919/2024 before the Apex Court, assailing the judgment and order dated 08.07.2024 rendered by this Court in CWP No. 2215/2024, wherein the Apex Court vide interim order dated 11.11.024 stayed operation of the aforesaid judgment and order dated 08.07.2024 of this Court.



2.1 The said Petition for Special Leave to Appeal is pending consideration even today.

Since the benefit appears to have been extended to the petitioners, the contempt petition stands disposed of with liberty extended to the petitioners to revive the contempt petition, in case occasion arises depending upon final verdict of the Apex Court in Petition for Special Leave to Appeal No. 25919/2024.
