Petitioner assails order dated 24.01.2025 of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Yamuna Nagar at Jagahri vide which application filed by the respondent under Section 125 Cr.P.C. was allowed *ex parte* and he was directed to pay monthly maintenance amounting to Rs. 12,000/- from the date of filing of the application.

Heard.

It appears that an application under Section 145(2) BNSS(126(2) Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner/husband for setting aside the *ex parte* judgment dated 24.01.2025. That application is fixed for 30.09.2025 before learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Yamuna Nagar at Jaghdhri. Meanwhile, the wife also filed an execution petition under Section 144 BNSS (Section 125(3) Cr.P.C.) for execution of the order dated 24.01.2025.
