1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.17 dated 05.03.2024 registered under Sections 363 & 366-A of IPC at Police Station Vairoke, District Fazilka.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 23.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mahinder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.
