1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.206 dated 07.12.2024, under Sections 21(b), 29, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.
2. Vide order dated 03.03.2025, while granting interim protection, petitioners were directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 03.03.2025, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Status report by way of affidavit of Ms. Heena Gupta, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rural Bathinda has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, in the Court today, same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who seeks time to go through the same and address arguments.
