1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in a case FIR No. 02, dated 18.01.2025, under Section 7 of P.C Act, registered at Police Station ACB, Faridabad (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the present case and no recovery was effected from him. However, the tainted money was planted on him, just to involve him in a false case. Learned counsel further contends that even there was no demand of bribe by him, as alleged by the complainant. The petitioner was arrested in the present case on 10.03.2025 and is in custody for the last four months. After completion of investigation, challan has been presented against him. He further contends that the prosecution has placed reliance on 18 witnesses, but no witness has been examined so far.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is a police official and serious allegations have been levelled against him.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully in the present case.

5. In the present case, the petitioner was arrested on 10.03.2025 and after completion of investigation, challan has already been presented against him. Since, no witness has been examined so far, there are no chances of early conclusion of the trial.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.

7. Pending application(s), if any, stand(s), disposed of, accordingly.
