RA-CW-71-2025 in CWP PIL No. 281 of 2024

This application seeks review of the final order dated 23.01.2025 passed by this Court wherein though it was held that against the order dated 04.12.2024 remedy of appeal/revision lies to the Bar Council of India but while disposing of the petition this Court had expressed hope and expectation that Bar council of Punjab and Haryana shall rise to the occasion and take remedial steps to remove the element of bias arising from inclusion of one of the members in the Disciplinary Committee i.e. Shri Harinder Pal Singh Ishar.

2. Review applicant-petitioner No.1 appearing in person though submits that Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana has removed Shri Harinder Pal Singh Ishar as member of the Disciplinary Committee but lot of many issues remain unresolved.

3. Review applicant-petitioner No.1 has pointed out various causes of action in the review application which have arisen subsequent to the passing of the order under review. The causes which arise subsequent to the passing of the order under review cannot be raised as a ground to seek review of the final order.

4. In view of the above, the present review application is not maintainable and is dismissed as such.

5. This Court, however, observes that the enquiry being conducted by the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana shall be conducted in a free, fair and expeditious manner.
