Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.52 dated 23.09.2024 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC and under Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

As per Status report, at bottom of page No.9, it has been mentioned that the petitioner had joined the investigation but he did not hand over his passport.

One affidavit has been filed by the petitioner to the effect that passport of the petitioner has been kept by Nikhil Kumar, Immigration Consultant, R.S. Travels along with some other documents and he is not in possession of the passport.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, has stated that as in compliance of order dated 27.05.2025 passed by this

Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation, he is not required for further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid submission made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief, as extended to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 27.05.2025, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/ called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 482(2) BNSS.
