MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 482 BNSS in case FIR No.239 dated 24.10.2024, under Sections 190, 191(2), 115(2), 351(2), 110 of the B.N.S., 2023, registered at P.S. Rampura, District Rewari.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 22.11.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation.

“The learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that, the injury(ies) attributed to the petitioner is “simple in nature”. Moreover, the petitioner has clean antecedents and he is ready and willing to join the

investigation and to cooperate with the investigating officer.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.11.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 22.11.2024 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./Section 482(2) BNSS. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
