Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the order dated 15.9.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.)-9, Jalandhar vide which the petitioner was proceeded against ex-parte and warrants of attachment of property of the JD-Petitioner were issued and his pension account has been attached; as well as for setting aside the order dated 15.12.2018 vide which Manager of the Bank was directed to submit statement of account (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner in Execution Application bearing CIS No.EXE/450/2017 titled as 'Surinder Kaur Dhillon vs. Inderjit Singh Dhillon'.
