The aforesaid petition was filed on 12.11.2024 by Mr. Jagraj Singh Khiva, Advocate. However, certain objections were raised by the Registry on 12.11.2024.

As per Rule 9, Chapter I, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition, on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel party, who filed it, to re-file within a period of 40 days. However, the same was not taken back for refiling after removal of objections. On failure, the case is to be listed before the Court for orders.
