This is an application under Section 11 (6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

In view of the above, the application is disposed of by appointing Mr. S.K.Chopra, Additional District & Sessions Judge (Retd.), # 243, Sector 10, Panchkula, as an arbitrator to adjudicate upon disputes and differences between the parties.
