1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.190, dated 22.08.2024, under Sections 25-54-59 of Arms Act and 132(353 IPC), 221 (186 IPC), 351(1)[503 IPC] of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1).
2. Vide order dated 26.09.2024, while granting the interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 26.09.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jatinder Pal has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 26.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS.
