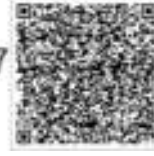

**MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-**

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 86 dated 20.02.2023 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC (Sections 411, 467, 468, 471, 201 read with Section 120-B of IPC added later on) at Police Station Sector 27, District Sonapat.

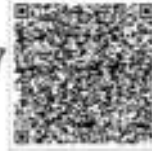
2. Brief facts of the case relevant for the purpose of disposal of this petition are that the aforementioned FIR had been registered on the basis of a complaint lodged by the Assistant Manager of IndusInd Bank, Sector-15, Sonipat Branch alleging therein that the present petitioner along with the co-accused, by using forged documents, by affixing ID proofs of some persons had got released vehicle loans for four cars on different points of time in the months of October, 2022, from the bank. The entire amount of loan was disbursed by the bank to the dealers. The petitioner and co-accused



had taken delivery of the cars from the respective dealers. However, on making inquires about the KYC, it was revealed that the documents of identification i.e. Aadhar Card, PAN card, salary slips, Form-16 and bank account statement were all forged. It was revealed that bank was duped of an amount of Rs. 31,90,000/- by the petitioner and the co-accused and also that two of the cars make of Wagon-R which were got delivered by the accused from the respective dealers, had been recovered from the custody of the petitioner-Sonu during the course of conducting inquiry. Prayer was made for taking action in the matter.

3. As per the further allegations, during the course of investigation, co-accused Surya Dev was arrested on 20.08.2023 and suffered disclosure statement admitting his involvement in the crime and also took the name of the petitioner and the co-accused. The present petitioner and co-accused could not be arrested. Challan was presented against the co-accused Surya Dev. The co-accused Rakesh Kumar was joined into investigation subsequently and was extended benefit of pre-arrest bail. The petitioner was arrested on 23.07.2024 and co-accused Kiran was arrested on 01.08.2024. They suffered disclosure statements and while admitting the factum of their involvement in the crime, gave the details of the manner in which the forged documents were submitted before the complainant-bank and loan was procured. The accused Kiran got recovered one Swift Dzire make car bearing registration No. HR-12AR-5115.

4. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner on the grounds and it is argued by his counsel that he has been falsely implicated in this case. He is in custody since 23.07.2024. His custodial interrogation is no



more required. Trial is likely to take time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody anymore. The petitioner has no criminal antecedents. The co-accused Rakesh Kumar and Surya Dev have been extended benefit of bail. On parity, he too deserves to be released on bail. With these broad submissions, it is urged that the petition deserves to be allowed.

5. Custody certificate has been filed by respondent-State. It is argued by learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana that there are serious allegations against the petitioner. Therefore, it is urged that he does not deserve to be released on bail.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties at considerable length and have gone through the record carefully.

7. As per the allegations, the petitioner and co-accused hatched a conspiracy and in pursuance thereof, the accused Surya Dev by impersonating himself as one Pankaj Gupta, and by submitting false and fabricated documents of identity got loan for purchase of a car approved for complainant-Bank. Investigation has been completed. Challan has been presented in the Court. Trial is likely to take time. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents. He is in custody since 23.07.2024. The co-accused Surya Dev and Rakesh Kumar have been extended benefit of anticipatory bail. It is well settled proposition of law that bail is the rule and jail is an exception. In view of the above discussed facts but without meaning to make any comment on the merits of the case, I am of the considered opinion that the petition deserves to be allowed. Hence, the same is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his



furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

7. Since the main petition has been allowed, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
