The instant petition under Section 482 of the BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.51, dated 15.04.2025, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nadha, District Patiala.

This Court vide order dated 26.05.2025, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.
