**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)**

The present petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 12.05.2004 passed in CWP No. 5927 of 1983.

The grievance is that the revised pension and the payment due thereto has not been made.

Learned Sate counsel, on instructions from Mr. Bhupinder Singh, Sr. Assistant, O/o Director Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab, submits that the revised pension has been calculated, arrears have been paid and now the petitioner is being paid revised pension.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the arrears paid are not for the entire period.

In order to resolve the controversy, respondents shall hand over the details of calculations of the arrears paid to the petitioner within two weeks.

In case of any grievance, petitioner would move a detailed representation alongwith his calculations and the said representation shall be decided by respondent No.2-Director, Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab by affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter. If still aggrieved the petitioner shall avail remedies in accordance with law.

In view of above, the petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.
