1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for quashing/setting aside of impugned order dated 04.12.2024 (Annexure P-3), passed by learned ASJ/JSC, Bathinda, in case CIS SC No.317/2022 titled as '*State of Punjab V/s Jasvir Singh @ Chitti*' (Annexure P-2), vide which the bail bond/surety bond of the petitioner was cancelled and he was summoned through non-bailable warrants in FIR No.103 dated 24.07.2022 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 109, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to appear and surrender before the trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, petitioner be protected till his appearance before the learned trial Court, and directions be given to the learned trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.



4. On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Deol, Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the trial Court within seven days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. This shall, however, be subject to payment of costs in the sum of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the concerned District Legal Services Authority.

6. It is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to surrender before the trial Court within seven days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail, the trial Court shall make earnest efforts to decide it expeditiously, in accordance with law.
