ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to take appropriate action on the complaint dated 01.09.2025 (P-2), petitioner has come up before this Court by filing the present petition under Section 528 BNSS 2023.

2. Counsel for the State on instructions from SI Baljeet Singh, submits that the complaint dated 01.09.2025 (Annexure P-2) was made by the petitioner because petitioner never joined the investigation.

3. After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied if petitioner is permitted to file fresh representation before the concerned Inspector General of Police, and if direction be issued to the Inspector General of Police to decide the same in time bound manner.

4. Counsel for the State has no objection if the above said prayer is accepted.

5. Given above, present petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file fresh representation before the concerned Inspector General of Police, within 15 days from today. If the petitioner files a precise representation within the above-mentioned time period, then, the same shall be decided by the concerned Inspector General of Police, within two months from that day positively, either himself/herself or by authorizing and delegating it to any officer of IPS Cadre. It is clarified that order so passed must be a reasoned order, and the same be communicated to the

representationists as well as his counsel, without any delay on their e-mail as mentioned on the representation. Liberty reserved to the petitioner to file fresh petition or to take other legal remedies in accordance with the law. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed.
