Status report filed by the respondent – State through Registry
in CRM-M-24324-224 is taken on record, subject to just exceptions. Copy
supplied to the opposite counsel.

Learned State counsel pointed out that CRM-M-24324-2024
for quashing of DDR No.13 dated 07.09.2023 is based on the partial
compromise arrived at between four accused in-fact there were 6 accused
in the DDR whereas FIR No.82 dated 06.09.2023 in CRM-M-24364-2024
is cross-case.

Learned counsel for petitioners in CRM-M-24324-2024 submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh as and when compromise is arrived at between all the accused persons with complainant in DDR No.13 dated 07.09.2023.

Since compromise could not mature in cross-version, therefore, learned counsel for petitioner in CRM-M-24364-2024 seeks permission to withdraw present petition with liberty to file afresh as and when compromise matures in DDR No. 13 dated 07.09.2023.

In view of statements, both petitions referred above stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
