MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.274 dated 20.08.2024 under Sections 115, 117(2), 126, 190, 191(2), 191(3), 351(3) of the BNS, 2023 (Section 118(2) of the BNS 2023 added lateron) registered at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

2. On 15.10.2024, this Court while issuing notice of motion had recorded the following submissions:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and grievous injury on the shoulder of the injured has been falsely attributed to him with a datar.”

3. Thereafter, on 29.10.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had



granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“On being put to notice, learned State counsel has not disputed the contentions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the previous date of hearing that the petitioner has been attributed injuries on non-vital parts of the injured/complainant i.e. right shoulder and left hand. It has been further submitted that the said injury was inflicted with the rear side of the datar.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 29.10.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from PSI Lalit Kumar, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 29.10.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
