1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner and his wife in a case arising out of FIR No.27, dated 13.04.2025, under Sections 109,126(2), 191(3) and 190 of B.N.S and under Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 18.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police Kapurthala, Punjab-respondent No.3 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is

allowed with a direction to respondent No.3- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, Punjab to look into representation dated 18.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
