AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J.(ORAL)

Counsel for the respondents, on the basis of details mentioned in para 2 of the affidavit dated 26.10.2013 filed by Shri Sukhchain Singh Gill, IPC, Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, states that all the dues which the petitioner was entitled to as per the direction issued by this Court in CWP No.16479 of 2012 have been granted to him and directions complied with. He further states that in case, anything else is still due to the petitioner, it would be open to the petitioner to make representation to that effect before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, who would consider the same and take decision thereon within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of such representation. On decision of the representation, if something more is found due to the petitioner, the same shall also be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

In view of the above statement of the counsel for the State, the present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
