The instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for setting aside the order dated 10.07.2025 passed by learned Special Judge (PMLA), Panchkula (Annexure P-1), vide which the respondent has been granted permission to travel abroad (USA) for 9 days in case complaint No.COMA-1 dated 14.01.2022 under Sections 44, 45, 3, 4 of Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002, registered at District Panchkula.

2. Mr. Gurmohan Singh Bedi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed his Power of Attorney in the Court today, which is taken on record.
