SURYA PARTAP SINGH. J.(Oral)

1. Mr. Ajay Singh, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and files Power of Attorney. The same be taken on record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that this petition may be disposed of by giving a liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one month and thereafter, the learned trial Court be directed to dispose of the bail application if moved by the petitioner within a fixed time frame.
3. In view of above-mentioned submissions, the present petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court within period of 02 months and after surrender, if he moves an application for bail, the learned trial Court is directed to dispose of the same within a period of one week. It is however made clear that from

the date of surrender, till the date of decision of bail application, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to detain the petitioner in custody, or impose penalty under Section 491 BNSS (erstwhile Section 446 Cr.P.C.)

4. The present petition stands disposed of.
5. On arrival of petitioner on Airport, he will have to surrender before the trial Court within 48 hours and during this period the petitioner would not be taken into custody.
