On 20.03.2025, on behalf of the appellants statement was made to accept ₹13,95,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹13,95,000/- (₹ Thirteen Lakh Ninety Five Thousand Only) is allowed to the appellants against the Insurance Company. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant Nos.1 and 2 in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹13,95,000/- in the respective names of appellant Nos.1 and 2 in equal shares with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 08.05.2025, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt
