1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to conduct fair and free investigation in FIR No. 30 dated 24.02.2020 registered under Sections 307, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act at Police Station Majitha Road, Amritsar and to transfer the investigation in this case to an officer not below the rank of IPS or outside the district.
2. Learned State counsel, at the outset on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh submits that nothing survives in the present petition as investigation in this case has already been concluded by the Investigating Agency and cancellation report has been filed before the jurisdictional Court and the same is pending consideration before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar and the petitioner has the remedy to file protest petition.
3. In view of the fact that cancellation report has been filed by the jurisdictional police authorities, no further directions are required to be issued in the present case and the present petition is hereby disposed of accordingly.
