1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against respondents for non-compliance of order dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by this court in CWP-6534-2022.

2. In compliance of order dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by this court in CWP-6534-2022, the counsel for the State has placed on record copy of communication dated 21.02.2024 sent by respondent, which is taken on record.

3. The counsel for the respondent-State, after going through the aforesaid communication, has submitted that the representation of the petitioner has been considered. Accordingly, the order qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with. No further action is required in the matter. Hence, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
