1. On 15.02.2023, the following order was passed:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner, upon instructions, submits that the petitioner undertakes to pay Rs.5,00,000/- by way of demand draft to the respondent No.1 herein on 21.02.2023, which is the next date of hearing before the learned Executing Court.

Notice of motion.

As the petitioner has undertaken to pay the above-said amount before the learned Executing Court on the next date of hearing 21.02.2023, subject to the petitioner making payment of Rs.5,00,000/-, the arrest warrants issued against the petitioner are stayed till the next date of hearing. In case the petitioner fails to make payment of Rs.5,00,000/- on 21.02.2023 as above-said, order of stay shall automatically stand vacated.

At the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, parties are referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for amicable settlement of the dispute. Parties are directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 10.03.2023.

Report of Mediation and Conciliation Centre be placed before this Court on 26.05.2023.

2. As per report submitted by the Mediator, the parties have settled their dispute and the petitioner has made some payment to the respondent-



Bank.

3. Called twice. Learned counsel representing the parties are not present. It appears that the parties have already settled their dispute.

4. Hence, the revision petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
