Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that vide letter dated 11.08.2025, a copy of which has been handed over to this Court, which is taken on record as Mark A, the services of the petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 01.10.2003 on notional basis as per the Court order, subject to the final outcome of the SLP to be filed in Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India. It is further submitted that the arrears from the date of filing of petition i.e., 16.02.2004 would be paid to the petitioner within a period of two months positively from today.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, the present



petition be disposed of at this stage but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case the respondents back track from the statement made before this Court. It is submitted that the respondents be bound by the statement made before this Court.

3. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of and the respondents would be bound by the statement made before this Court. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition in case the respondents back track from the statement.

4. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
