JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to consider him against 195 posts which are going to be filled up pursuant to directions of this Court in *CWP-25491-2023, Balwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others*.

2. The petitioner claims that this Court vide order dated 30.04.2024 passed in CWP-25491-2023 directed the respondent to fill up 195 posts which were lying vacant. The aforesaid posts were advertised vide Advertisement No.1 of 2016 dated 31.05.2016.

3. The respondent pursuant to directions of this Court has issued list of 195 candidates who are eligible for the post of Constable. The petitioner claims that respondent has not considered 4 marks earmarked for interview. The respondent is bound by terms and conditions of the advertisement.

4. A co-ordinate Bench of this Court in *Raghvir Singh and others vs.*



State of Punjab and others, 2021 SCC OnLine P&H 3060 has held that selection shall be made without considering marks of interview. The respondent in terms of directions of this Court has selected candidates on the basis of written test and physical test. The marks of interview are not considered. This Court in view of judgment dated 05.07.2021 passed in **Raghvir (supra)** cannot ask respondent to consider marks of interview and thereafter prepare merit list.
