1. This Court vide order dated 07.04.2025, passed the hereinabove extracted order:-

“Due to indolent and lackadaisical approach of the District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Gurugram, (respondent No.4), who has not decided the complaint/representation, and some of the applications for implementation of the order dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-7), as passed by the respondent No.3, and order dated 11.12.2024 (Annexure P-12), as passed by the respondent No.2, since long. The details of which are mentioned in Paragraph No.29 of the instant petition.

This Court, vide order dated 02.04.2025, had passed the hereinafter extracted order, upon the instant petition :-

“The main grievance of the petitioner as encapsulated in the instant case, is, not taking any decision on the applications/petitions which are pending before the District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Haryana (respondent no.4), as detailed in para no.29 as well as pending before the Registrar General, Firms and Societies (respondent no.2), as detailed in para no.30, of the instant petition.

At this stage, without issuing notice of motion, learned State counsel is directed inform this Court, after having apt instructions from the respondents concerned, as to how much time, is required to take a final decision in the petitions/applications (supra).

Adjourned to 07.04.2025.”

In deference to the directions (supra), issued by this Court, learned counsel for the State, informs this Court today, that due information was sought from the District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Haryana, respondent No.2, telephonically. However, the Registrar concerned, instead of providing any apposite information, informed that he has transferred all these matters to the District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Faridabad. Furthermore, it has been informed to this Court, that respondent No.2, has also misbehaved with the learned counsel for the State.

Let the Registrar General of Firms and Societies, Haryana, respondent No.2, as well as District Registrar of Firms and Societies, Gurugram, respondent No.4, shall cause their personal appearance, before this Court, on the next date of hearing, and inform this Court :-

- i) whether, the District Registrar concerned, is within his power, to transfer any petition/complaint or application, which clearly falls in his territorial jurisdiction;
- ii) whether, non-providing adequate information to this Court, require apposite action against the delinquent District Registrar concerned.

List this matter on 09.04.2025. To be shown in the urgent list. It is made clear that on the next date of hearing, no request for an adjournment on behalf of either of the parties concerned, shall be entertained.

2. In pursuance to the aforesaid directions, Mr.Lokesh Yadav, District Registrar, and Mr.Yash Garg, Registrar General, Firms and Societies, Haryana, have caused appearance before this Court.

3. Mr.Lokesh Yadav, has tendered an unconditional apology before this Court for his conduct in dealing with the office of Advocate General.

4. The unconditional apology tendered by Mr.Lokesh Yadav, is accepted.

5. Further, both Mr. Lokesh Yadav and Mr. Yash Garg, submit before this Court that the petition, as has been preferred by the present petitioner, would be decided within a period of 04 weeks from the date of passing of this order.

6. In view of the specific stand taken by both the aforesaid officials, the instant petition is **disposed of**, accordingly.
