1. The present petition under Section 528 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner with the prayer to direct respondent No.2 to take appropriate steps against respondent No.4, who is alleged to have committed forgery and got prepared his fake death certificate.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been married to respondent No.4. Unfortunately, the relationship was not smooth. On account of temperamental issues, they could not live together. Matrimonial disputes are pending between the petitioner and his wife-respondent No.4. The petitioner has alleged that his wife-respondent No.4 tampered with the pension portal by misusing his personal documents and, thus, the pension was credited in her account. When he came to know of this forgery, criminal proceedings by way of FIR No.17 dated 24.4.2025, under Sections 318(4), 61(2) of BNS (Annexure P-1) was registered against her. Subsequently, it also came to the notice of the petitioner that fake death



certificate had also been prepared by respondent No.4. Police authorities were requested several times to initiate appropriate proceedings against her, but to no avail. In this context, a representation dated 18.6.2025 (Annexure P-5) was also moved to the local police officials to look into and enquire the matter. At this stage, the limited prayer of the petitioner is that the representation, as mentioned above, has not been decided till date.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to decide the representation dated 18.6.2025 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
