**KIRTI SINGH, J. (Oral)**

1. Apprehending arrest the petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.646 dated 21.12.2024, under Sections 80(2) and 3(5) of BNS, registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad.

2. The following order was passed on 21.01.2025:-

*“Apprehending arrest, the petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.646 dated 21.12.2024, under Sections 80(2) and 3(5) of BNS, registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad.*

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, submits that the petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased and has been falsely implicated in this case. Prior to this no complaint of harassment, cruelty, dowry demand, or threats were made against the petitioner or his family. The deceased, along with her husband and son, were living separately at 504A, Gurudwara Road, Jawahar Colony, Sector-22, Faridabad, Haryana, away from the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedents and is willing to join and cooperate in the investigation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. *Ms. Mahima Yaspal, DAG, Haryana waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to file reply.*

5. *List on 24.02.2025.*

6. *In the meantime, petitioner shall join investigation before the Investigating Agency/Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be*



*released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall abide by the following conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023:-*

*1) That the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required to do so.*

*2) That the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.*

*3) That the petitioner shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

3. Status report dated 21.02.2025 filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. He on instructions from SI Vinod Kumar submits that in compliance of order dated 21.01.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

4. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed. Order dated 21.01.2025 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.

5. This order should not be treated as "blanket" order. It will not be read granting the petitioner indefinite protection from arrest. It shall be confined to the FIR mentioned ibid and will not operate in respect of any other incident that involves commission of an offence.

6. This order does not in any manner limit or restrict the rights or duties of the police or investigating agency to investigate into the charges against the petitioner.

7. The accused/petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him or her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

8. The accused/petitioner shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.



9. The accused/petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called by the police.

10. It will be open to the police or the investigating agency to move to this Court for a direction under Section 483(3) of BNSS (erstwhile Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973) to arrest the accused, in the event of violation of any term, such as absconding, non-cooperating during investigation, evasion, intimidation or inducement to witnesses with a view to influence outcome of the investigation or trial.

Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of accordingly.
