1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.06.2022, in CWP-12560-2022.
2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-12560-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide pending representation dated 09.05.2022, by passing a speaking order within eight weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case. However, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 11.07.2022, passed by the respondent, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 09.05.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to

challenge order dated 11.07.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
