**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)**

1.             This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for non implementing the judgment and order dated 16.08.2022 passed in RSA-6409 & 6463-2014.

2.             A perusal of the file shows that the present petition has been filed on the basis of a decree passed by the lower Appellate Court, through which the petitioner was declared as owner in possession of the suit property. Beyond that, there is no positive directions contained in the decree, as such. Moreover, the petitioner is having alternate remedy of getting the decree executed, if he has any grievance based on the said decree.

3.             In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter.

4.             Dismissed.

5.             However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
