1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0289 dated 05.09.2018 under Sections 363/366-A IPC registered at Police Station, Bilaspur, District Gurugram in view of the affidavit dated 9.3.2024 (P-3) (compromise).

2. On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed in the main case:-

“Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is not on bail in the instant FIR. In support of his argument, he has produced copy of order dated 10.02.2025 passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Pataudi.
