Reply by way of affidavit of Upkaran Pal Singh, Executive Engineer, Bathinda Canal Division, Bathinda has been filed in court. Same is taken on record. Learned State counsel submits that sanction has been granted for payment to the petitioner and the amount has been sent to the Treasury. He has referred to para 5 of the affidavit. Same reads as under:-

“5. That the payment to the petitioner is to be released directly by the District Treasury Officer, Bathinda by online mode (through ECS System) by putting the amount into the bank account of the petitioner. The deponent has issued reminder to Distt. Treasury Officers, Bathinda for releasing the payment to the petitioner at the earliest (Annexure R/4-2).”

He further submits that the payment shall be made at the earliest, in any case not later than two months.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition.
