1. Challenge in the present revision petition is to the order dated 22.02.2023 (Annexure P-9) vide which in a suit filed by the respondent-plaintiff, issues were framed without deciding the application filed under Section 124 of the Trade Marks Act, 1999.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the said application stands dismissed vide order dated 14.09.2023 and the petitioners have challenged the said order in separate proceedings.
