Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Smt. Sumitra Devi, District Education Officer, Jind submits that arrears of pension have been released in favour of the petitioner, however, with respect to interest, learned counsel for the respondent prays for two weeks' time.

In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition and the same is thus, disposed of.

Rule discharged.

It is made clear that in case the respondent fails to abide by the aforesaid undertaking towards release of interest within two weeks, salary of Smt. Sumitra Devi, District Education Officer, Jind shall remain attached to the extent of 1/3rd till the compliance is made.

However, the petitioner shall also be at liberty to avail his remedies as per law, in case, he still finds himself aggrieved of the fixation of revised pension.
