1. This petition has been filed praying for quashing of the order dated 04.02.2023 whereby petitioners No.1 and 2 have been declared as Proclaimed Offenders and order dated 23.02.2024 whereby petitioner No.3 has been declared as Proclaimed Offender in FIR No.1 dated 03.01.2021, under Sections 323, 341, 336, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act (offence under Arms Act deleted later on), at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar.

2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Sirivennela, IPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Model Town, Jalandhar filed on behalf of learned State counsel is taken on record.

Vide order dated 13.08.2024, the impugned orders dated 04.02.2023 and 23.02.2024 were stayed by this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners have appeared and joined the proceedings and as such, the present petition may be allowed.
